1. FULL DAY IN COTOPAXI NATIONAL PARK

Get ready to immerse yourself in the grandeur of Cotopaxi volcano with us!



This is a favorite activity of our guests. Did you know that after the Galapagos Islands, this is the second most visited national park in Ecuador?

Embark on a thrilling adventure as we explore the foothills of the majestic Cotopaxi, the world's highest active volcano towering at an impressive 5,897 meters (19,347 feet) above sea level.

Our meeting point will be the reception area of the lodge where you'll be greeted by a local guide who will take you to the park in a 4x4 vehicle. We'll arrive via the park's north entrance, just 6 km (3.73 miles) from Chilcabamba Lodge. We'll start the day with a panoramic view at the beautiful Limpiopungo Lagoon. We will then ascend to the Refuge's parking lot, from where we'll begin a 2-hour hike to reach the José Ribas Refuge at 4,800 meters (15,748 feet) above sea level. If weather conditions permit and your body tolerates the altitude well, we may even reach 5,000 meters (16,404 feet) to touch the imposing glacier of this majestic volcano! Finally, we'll conclude our day by visiting the fascinating archaeological ruins of Pucará del Salitre. Here, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy a delicious snack, relax and unwind after a day filled with unforgettable experiences.

2. HORSEBACK RIDING IN COTOPAXI NATIONAL PARK: AN EQUESTRIAN ADVENTURE

An exceptional experience for horse enthusiasts!



This thrilling journey begins at Rumicorral, strategically located within Cotopaxi National Park, just 7 km (4.35 miles) from our cozy lodge. Here you'll be welcomed by our experienced guide, an authentic local 'chagra,' who will provide a safety briefing before your adventure begins.

The guide will give you authentic ponchos and helmets to wear as you prepare to embark on an exciting horseback ride. We'll traverse the eastern foothills of the park, winding through beautiful grasslands. As we progress, you'll witness breathtaking views of nearby majestic volcanoes, including the imposing Sincholagua, the serene Rumiñahui, and the majestic Cotopaxi.



This experience is not only an opportunity to connect with nature but also a window into the rich 'chagra' culture. Get ready for an unforgettable equestrian adventure, where the resilience and authenticity of our four-legged companions will transport you to a world of natural beauty and authenticity!



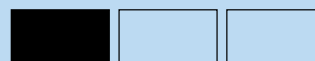

3. HIKING TO RUMIÑAHUI VOLCANO: AN ENCOUNTER WITH ANDEAN MAJESTY



Rumiñahui, an impressive dormant volcano nestled in the heart of Cotopaxi National Park, unfolds its unique beauty with three majestic summits, with the northern summit being the most imposing. In this thrilling journey, we will ascend towards its central summit, rising to 4,630 meters (15,190 feet).

Our experienced guide will pick you up at the lodge for a brief car ride (approximately 40 minutes). The starting point will be the picturesque Limpiopungo Lagoon, from where we will begin our ascent through high-altitude grasslands, wetlands, and sandy terrain, climbing along the mountain's central ridge to reach the base of its rocks. From this point, we will face the final rocky stretch, culminating in the conquest of the summit.

Throughout this beautiful day, you'll delight your senses with the characteristic flora and fauna of the high-altitude grassland while enjoying panoramic views of the surrounding majestic volcanoes: Cotopaxi, Sincholagua, Corazón, Pasochoa, and the serene Santo Domingo Valley.

Embark on this adventure, where Andean majesty reveals itself with every step and the summit of Rumiñahui offers an incomparable spectacle.

4. MOUNTAIN BIKING: EPIC DESCENT IN COTOPAXI



Embark on our thrilling mountain biking tour through the majestic Cotopaxi National Park, an experience that will immerse you in the magnificence of this protected area while enjoying an adventure on two wheels.

The journey begins early in the morning when you are picked up directly from the hotel to the starting point. Your first stop will be the parking area, located at 4,500 meters (14,764 feet) above sea level, where we'll reach the highest point of the route. From this privileged position, you'll enjoy panoramic views that stretch to take in 8 volcanoes on a clear day. Equipped with helmets, gloves, and protective gear, we'll start our thrilling mountain bike adventure by descending dirt roads for the first 8 km (4.97 miles). Volcanic terrain and tundra landscapes will unravel before you as you become immersed in this unique experience. As you descend to an altitude of 3,800 meters (12,467 feet), you'll pedal an additional 8 km (4.97 miles), surrounded by volcanic rocks and the beauty of wild horses in their natural habitat.

Our next destination is Limpiopungo Lagoon, situated at 3,800 meters (12,467 feet) altitude. Here, we'll begin an exciting 16 km (9.94 miles) bike descent, combining both dirt and paved roads. Finally, around 3:00 PM, we'll return to the lodge, concluding this incredible biking adventure that will be etched in your memory.

Get ready to experience adrenaline and natural beauty with every pedal turn!

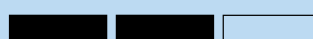

5. HIKE TO THE "CASCADA DE FUEGO" WATERFALL DISCOVER YOUR EXPLORER SIDE



This activity is perfect for those looking to explore the surrounding area of the lodge at their own pace. Walk along trails surrounded by petrified lava, and if you wish, take a short ascent among the rocks to reach a beautiful waterfall. Once there, you can rest, take photos, and refresh yourself with the rejuvenating breeze and spray from the 60-meter-high (197 feet) waterfall.

This activity can be done without a guide and will take you around 2 hours. Simply reach the trailhead parking lot just 6 km (3.73 miles) from the lodge, then follow the trail on the right side of the river.

6. HIKE INTO THE RIO PITA CANYON: DISCOVER EVERY CORNER ON FOOT



Immerse yourself in the magic of Rio Pita Canyon, where waters from the Cotopaxi and Sincholagua volcanoes give life to a beautiful adventure. This river is not only a natural treasure but also a vital water source for the city of Quito, adding a touch of importance to this exploration.

As you venture through the canyon, you'll appreciate traces of lava, silent witnesses of Cotopaxi's past eruptions. This circuit is done entirely on foot. Our guide will take you from the lodge to the heart of the canyon, passing by the captivating Firewater Waterfall and exploring various landscapes and community areas before returning to the lodge.

The ascent is gradual, allowing you to explore waterfalls, spot birds, learn about the rich diversity of plants, and stroll through lands cultivated by our local neighbors. We recommend you bring a box lunch, to recharge your batteries surrounded by the serenity of the environment.

To fully enjoy, we recommend bringing a box lunch or snacks - you can arrange this previously with us- as we'll make a special stop in a charming corner of the reserve. Is there anything better than enjoying a delicious lunch surrounded by nature?

This full day of waterfalls will provide you with a refreshing experience, connecting you with natural beauty at every step. Get ready to dive into a day of aquatic discoveries!

9. TROUT FISHING: A FAMILY ADVENTURE



A delightful fishing adventure awaits you just a short walk from our lodge at the trout pond located on our neighbor's property in Mauca Pedregal. It is perfect for enjoying a fun fishing excursion with your family!

To reach this spot, follow the lodge's internal trail for approximately 20 minutes, where you'll witness the rich diversity of local flora, such as blueberries, chuquiraguas, and chilcas, among others. On a clear day, your walk will be watched over by the majestic volcanoes that surround us.

Upon reaching the pool, you'll be greeted by our friendly neighbors, who will provide you with fishing rods, bait, and a bucket for your fishing experience. With a little patience and skill, you're sure to get your well-deserved reward! At the end, your catch will be weighed, cleaned, and ready for you to take home. Or, if you prefer, we can prepare it at the lodge for a delicious lunch.

A fishing day that will become a lifelong memory! Immerse yourself in the serenity of the pool and enjoy the authenticity of trout fishing in a natural setting.

10. COW MILKING: EXPERIENCE RURAL LIFE IN LORETO DEL PEDREGAL



In our peaceful community of Loreto del Pedregal, neighbors are dedicated to growing potatoes, cereals, and producing milk, either for local consumption or sale. In this authentic activity you'll have the opportunity to immerse yourself in the lives of our neighbors and learn about their traditions.

A friendly guide will greet you at the lodge reception and take you to the pasture where their cows graze in a walk of approximately 20 minutes. Milking will be done manually, following the ancestral technique that some of our neighbors still practice. It is necessary to make your reservation at least 24 hours in advance.

Once in Quilotoa, you'll have the chance to descend about 2 km on foot along a dirt trail that leads to the beautiful and serene turquoise lake. Enjoy moments of tranquility by the enchanting waters. Later, you'll have to ascend to the trailhead, and you can relax at one of the local restaurants, savoring delicious dishes and exploring the small craft shops that adorn the area.

After absorbing all the beauty and energy of Quilotoa, our guide will take you back to the lodge.

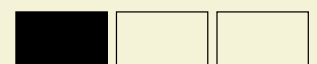

Our guide will be waiting for you at the lodge reception to take you on a drive of approximately 75 km, around two hours, to reach the Antisana Ecological Reserve. During the journey, you can observe small lagoons in the old Antisanilla volcano, where you can also spot different birds such as hummingbirds and blackbirds, among others. Within the reserve, you'll be amazed by the beauty of La Mica Lagoon. From this point, you'll have the option to explore various trekking trails, rest, and enjoy a delicious picnic lunch.

Immerse yourself in the majesty of the Andes, observe the imposing presence of the Antisana volcano, and be captivated by the pristine nature surrounding La Mica lagoon. A full day's adventure in Antisana, full of natural wonders and unforgettable experiences.
